New Staff Welcome // John & Leneita Fix

Leneita still remembers the day she first walked into her interview at Aslan. Often she will say that it was like God himself revealed to Craig the details of Leneita's heart for ministry. Aslan's mission was to see the Lord straighten broken lives through the power of relationship. How could she walk away?

First, Leneita joined Aslan's staff, followed by her husband, John. That was almost 17 years ago. For a decade, Leneita and John aided Aslan in serving urban families in Monmouth County through a variety of roles. It saddened the couple when the Lord started to call them to journey with him elsewhere. Their heartbeat and how they approached life and ministry was that of Aslan. This was the place they had "grown up" in urban ministry!

Yet, Leneita and John listened to the Lord and with heavy hearts followed his call. For the last 7 years, John has served at Urban Youth Impact in West Palm Beach, Florida in two capacities - first as the Director of Operations and then as the Director of Programs. John's responsibilities have included strategic planning, staff development, grant writing, budget development and oversight, IT development, and facilities management. John also guided the administrative leadership team in developing UYI's 10year plan to improve programming outcomes, increase the number of youth being reached, complete renovations on its 30,000 square foot facility, and increase staffing to accommodate this growth.

In the meantime, Leneita has been equally as busy. This year, she celebrated her 20th year in ministry. While on staff with John at UYI, her responsibilities included Bible-based program direction for children ages 5-18, curriculum writing, staff training and recruiting, discipleship and resource creation. She also coordinated all aspects of training for Urban Youth Workers Institute. The Lord has used her in unique ways on the national level by providing opportunities to write curriculum, speak, train and partner with youth conferences. This year, Leneita published her first book, *No Teenager Left Behind*, while being featured in three multi-author books with Group Publishing.

During their time away, Aslan was never far from Leneita's and John's hearts. Their philosophy of ministry - to provide relationship-based programs to inner city youth who need to know that God has created them with a purpose and a future - was that legacy John and Leneita carried. About a year ago, Christ began to show them once again that he was calling to follow in a new direction. The thought came and went that they would love to return to Aslan and to the core of how they learned to do ministry.

No one could imagine in those initial explorative conversations that Leneita and John would come "home" to this ministry. Still, there is no doubt that the Lord used their time away to develop them in tremendous ways. They are excited to return to Aslan and utilize this experience to advance the mission and vision that God has put in place.
